

Check out the best local skiers and snowboarders as they battle, street style at a rail and jump exhibition.



ABOUT US

Officially New Zealand's Best Ski Resort for the eighth year in a row.* Mt Hutt is Canterbury's big friendly mountain with some of the most consistent snowfall in the country delivering a long, white season.

At an altitude of 2086m with a 683 vertical drop Mt Hutt boasts the South Island's highest chairlift, leg-burning runs and some of the country's most spectacular views.

As well as genuine Kiwi hospitality, guests can enjoy wide groomed slopes, lift access for all abilities, top to bottom terrain parks and some of the best off-piste skiing around. Mt Hutt has 365 ha of skiable terrain and state of the art snowmaking to top up the slopes.

Mt Hutt is striving to become carbon neutral. To achieve this, substantial investment has been put into upgrading equipment, waste management initiatives and native planting.

Other specific carbon reduction initiatives include the recent upgrade of our trail grooming fleet, utilisation of SnowSAT technology and installation of energy-efficient snowmaking technology.

Mt Hutt also hopes to encourage more native birds back to the mountain by creating a habitable environment for them through pest eradication and native planting.

From 5 to 15 years and a licensed creche taking children from 2 to 5 years.


