ABOUT US

The Remarkables ski area is where you'll find your freedom. Located in the adventure capital of the world - Queenstown, New Zealand - it's not hard to see why this place is so addictive.

Our mountain is a welcoming, adventurous ski area boasting three sun-drenched, north-facing bowls and up to seven terrain parks.

Known for being one of the best mountains for progression, the ski area offers a range of terrain to suit everyone. From off-piste black runs and daring chutes to wide-open learner slopes and everything in between.

The iconic mountain is the Home of Freeride in New Zealand and annually hosts the country's only World Freeride Qualifier events.

The Remarkables is also home to the Southern Hemisphere's only Freeride World Tour Academy.

Within the last eight years, strong investment has seen the development of an extensive snowmaking set up, the installation of two new chairlifts and an award winning base building – all of which contribute to the world-class facilities on mountain.

Along with sister mountains, Coronet Peak and Mt Hutt, The Remarkables is dedicated to Kaitiakitanga, which focuses on continued restoration and enhancement of our environment.

SNOWMAKING

Extensive automated system comprising 158 guns covering beginners' area, Alta Green, Casterway, Gotham City, Curvey, Cross Fall, Serpentine, Turquoise, Waterfall, and terrain parks.

Three high-speed six-seater chairs, one quad chair, four surface conveyor lifts including three with covered galleries.

AVERAGE SNOWFALL 3.67m per annum (excl. snowmaking).

ACCESS 24km, 45min from Queenstown (9km sealed and 4km unsealed access road).

TERRAIN 30% beginner, 40% intermediate, 30% advanced.

NON SKIERS Chairlift to sightseeing access point and a toboggan area.

SNOWSPORTS Private and group coaching available as well as high performance camps and adaptive programmes.

KIDS PROGRAMMES Ages 4-5years & 5-16 years.

FOOD & BEVERAGE Restaurant and bar services, cafe, Corona Ice Bar, and Barista Bar.

RENTALS Recreational and performance rental gear available as well as an on-mountain workshop for equipment tuning.

SUSTAINABLE SLOPES

HERE AT THE REMARKABLES WE'RE ON A MISSION TO DO THE BEST WE CAN BY OUR ENVIRONMENT.

In 2023 we made a commitment to be carbon neutral by 2030. We know it's a big goal, but we're ready for it, and we're already part way there.

We're proudly guided by the concepts of kaitiakitanga (meaning: guardianship and protection) and manaakitanga (meaning: respect, generosity and care). We understand and acknowledge that our environment is the backbone of our operation, and it's our responsibility to look after it. We don't take anything we do for granted and our promise to share our passion for the mountain has never felt as important as it does right now, as we continue our journey to carbon neutral by 2030.

To kick start our journey of becoming carbon neutral by 2030, we reduced our net carbon emissions by 50% in 2023 and we'll do the same again in 2024.

HERE'S THE NUTS AND BOLTS:

- We've purchased Meridian Energy's Certified Renewable Energy product. In conjunction with our emission reduction programs it also means we can report our market-based scope 2 emissions as zero* (our scope 2 emissions are currently reported as over 1000T per annum).
- 2. Purchasing Carbon Credits from Carbonz the credits come from native vegetation blocks in the Otago and Canterbury regions; for 2023 this offset 400T.

You'll notice carbon offsetting is one part of our multi-pronged approach. We know this isn't a long-term solution and overtime the native trees we plant will begin to sequester carbon, taking over from the credits we purchase. Our most important focus is ensuring we're doing all we can to minimise our emissions through our carbon reduction initiatives.

We are always working to do more, but we think this is a pretty good start as we continue our decarbonisation journey. For more information please visit our 'Sustainable Slopes' page on our website.
